
Responding to the needs across the world: Floods in Kerala

Farming communities in rural southern Malawi have suffered severe hardship because of changing and unpredictable weather patterns. However, by starting to grow the drought-resistant and commercially valuable crop, the remarkable Pigeon Pea, people's lives are being transformed, bringing them new hope for the future. This year the Bishop of St Albans harvest appeal is to support people just like Frank who four years ago had to walk 4 miles to hospital to get treatment for his 4 year old son, carrying him in his arms.
